- Talking and Listening respond to a range of fiction, tell, re-tell and interpret stories, participate in discussions, improvise scenes from curriculum topics.
- Reading Modelled, Shared, Paired & Guided (Literacy World, AR, Class Novels e.g. Under the Hawthorn Tree). Extend the range of pupil's reading develop awareness of fact and fiction. Use range of strategies for unfamiliar words. Justify responses by inference, deduction & reference to text.
- Writing Modelled, Shared & Independent writing. Write for a variety of purposes e.g. persuasive, procedural etc. Develop increasing competence in use of grammar and punctuation. Develop legible style of writing (Pen licence).





Processes in Maths

- Making & monitoring decisions plan & organise work. Identify & obtain information required for task. Develop range of strategies for problem-solving. Communicate mathematically understand mathematical language, compare ideas & work with others.
- Mathematical reasoning Check & re-check work. Recognise patterns
 & relationships.
- Number place value, times tables, fractions, 4 operations...
- ► Measures length, weight, volume, capacity, time, area, temperature...
- ► Shape & Space 2D & 3D shapes, angles, co-ordinates...
- **Handling Data** interpret graphs, tables, lists...

Reading – 20 minutes per night.

Spelling – Spelling workbooks £5 (online) – activities are completed at home on a set of list words which change every 2 weeks. There will be a test every week.

Mental Maths – A maths facts book/worksheet will be used every night.





Tests will be completed on a Monday and Wednesday. The children will have the opportunity to go over these tests on Tuesday and Thursday.

- The three AQE tests will be on Saturday 19th November, Saturday 26th November and Saturday 3rd December.
- GL (Granada Learning) Registration for GL closes on 23rd September at 2pm.

- If tutor please avoid past papers as we will be completing potentially 26 tests in school.
